

Indicators for Hospice Referrals - HIV

A checklist for clinicians including Emergency Department staff

Numbers 1, 2 and 3 should be present. Factors from number 4 will add supporting documentation. Patients who do not fully meet the criteria may still be deemed eligible for hospice based on the totality of their clinical picture and documentation of such.
